## Tuition & Fee Guidelines

### Registration Fee

1. Must be paid in full at the time of registration and before student(s) take their first class.
2. The registration fee is non-refundable, non-transferable and is not prorated any time during the year.

### Activity Fee

1. Activity Fee must be paid in full at time of registration.
2. Activity Fee is non-refundable and non-transferable.

### Tuition

#### General Information

1. The tuition is non-refundable, non-transferable and is not prorated based on missed classes or other centre closings.
2. A \$20.00 late fee applies to all accounts not paid by within 5 days of the due date specified by your payment plan selection or by other fee due dates.
3. Payment Options are selected and agreed upon on or before August 30, 2008.
4. A fee of \$30.00 is charged for all returned payments. If there are two returned payments on your account, the account will be placed on "Cash Only" basis.
5. Scholarships are offered based on demonstrated financial need and are available to students who have attended the Centre for one or more years.
6. Parent(s) must provide 30 days written notice if student is to be withdrawn from program, regardless of the payment plan selected.

#### **++** Annual Payments

1. All students must be registered by August 30, 2008 to qualify for the discount.
2. 1st Tuition Installment is due at time of registration.
3. Remaining balance is due on or before August 30, 2008.

#### **\*** Two Installments (2IP)

1. All students must be registered by August 30, 2008 to qualify for the discount.
2. August Tuition is paid at time of registration.
3. Payment Plan begins with September.
  - 1st Installment due on or before August 30, 2008.
  - Final Installment is due on or before January 3, 2009.

#### **φ** Three Installments (3IP)

1. August Tuition is paid at time of registration
2. Payment Plan begins in September
  - 1st Installment due on or before August 30, 2008 (September - November)
  - 2nd Installment is due on or before December 1, 2008 (December - February)
  - 3rd Installment is due on or before March 2, 2009 (March - May)

#### **Δ** Auto Debits

1. Auto Debit payments are the convenient alternative for families that cannot pay their annual tuition using one of the three other options above.
2. Parent(s) have the option to select for payments to be withdrawn on the 1st or the 15th of the month.
3. Tuition payments will be automatically charged to the credit card or debit card of your choice in 10 equal installments.
4. This authorization remains valid until such time that the parent provides 30 days written notice to the Phusion business office that student(s) is being withdrawn from the program.
5. The parent is responsible for notifying the business office in writing if there are any changes to their credit/debit card information.
6. Phusion is not liable for any negative impact to account due to insufficient funds.
7. The auto debit payment selection can not be changed during the year.
8. Auto Debits are non-refundable and non-transferable.

## Tuition & Fee Guidelines cont...

### Costumes

1. Parents should budget for the number of costumes according to the number of classes the student is registered for.
2. Costume fee is for the use, cleaning etc... for the costumes. Students may or may not be able to keep costumes. Decisions on what costumes may be kept by the student is at the discretion of the Artistic Director. All decisions are final.
3. Costume fees not paid on time could result in an additional costume expense including, but not limited to, shipping charges.
4. Costume fees not paid by the last installment date, may result in your student not being able to perform in the production.
5. The costume fee is non-refundable and non-transferable.

### Due Dates:

1st Half Installment - Saturday, November 15, 2008  
Final Installment - Saturday, January 17, 2009

### Production Fee

1. Production fee must be paid in full in order for the student to participate in the production.
2. Production fee covers the cost of securing a state of the art facility, ten tickets to the performance and a DVD of the production.
3. Production fee is non-refundable and non-transferable.

### Due Dates:

1st Installment - Saturday, October 11, 2008  
2nd Installment - Saturday, December 13, 2008  
Final Installment - Saturday, February 14, 2008

### Family Discount

1. In order to qualify for the family discount, the first student (primary student) must pay full price and additional student(s) must be siblings of the primary student and live in the same household. If additional student(s) are registered, after the primary student's registration has been completed, an additional registration fee will be required.
2. Discounts will be calculated based on the students with the lower tuition. Example: If you register one student for 3 classes and the second student registers for 2 classes, the student with 3 classes is considered the primary student and pays full tuition.
3. If you register an additional student after you register your primary student, your tuition will be adjusted according to Note 2 above.

### Private Lessons

1. All private lessons must be scheduled for and paid in advance at the Front Desk.
2. All private lessons are non-refundable and non-transferrable.
