



Dress Code

It's important for students to abide by a dress code policy for the following reasons:

- A neat and tidy appearance sets an attitude of attentiveness and respect for students, teacher, and the art of dance.
- Teachers must be able to see the dancer's body outline clearly in order to make proper corrections on posture, alignment, etc.

General Guidelines

- Students must have appropriate dance attire within 7 days of start date for classes.
- If student is not in appropriate dance attire (this includes tights with rips and holes), they may be asked to observe class. After 3rd offense, parent(s) will be notified and student may be placed on probation. Parents are still responsible for all tuition and dues during the probationary period.
- Students are NOT allowed to wear dance clothing with other dance schools logos while at Phusion. NO EXCEPTIONS!
- Hair must be properly secured and tied up off of the face and neck for all styles of dance. No hair scarves, rags or wraps permitted!
- Jewelry must not be loose or dangling. Small studs are permitted.
- No distracting nail colors or designs will be permitted.
- Gum chewing is not allowed due to danger of choking and appearance.
- No loose fitting pants, blue jeans or t-shirts (they are not dance attire).
- No costumes are allowed in class unless a dress up day is announced by the individual teacher.
- Due to time constraints, if a student has classes back to back, the student should wear leotards, tights and/or shorts under other clothing as appropriate.

Pointe

IMPORTANT NOTE: Pointe may only be taken at the discretion of the Artistic Director. Parents will be notified if their student is ready for pointe. Parents and students should refrain from asking the Artistic Director if they are ready for pointe. New students must be evaluated by the Phusion faculty and proper placement will be determined. For safety reasons, the Artistic Director has the final decision as to whether your student is ready for pointe.
